Armed Forces Voters Week



What is Armed Forces Voters Week

- Armed Forces Voters Week is a time to encourage Active Duty service members and their voting-age family members to vote by absentee ballot.
- Goal for IVAOs: Deliver the Federal Post Card Application (FPCA) to all Service members and their voting-age family members. Encourage everyone who wants to vote to fill out and submit the form immediately.
- 2018 Armed Forces Voters Week Dates: June 27-July 5, 2018
- Overseas Voters Week runs concurrently with Armed Forces Voters Week, and is aimed at Overseas Citizens

- Send a link to the FPCA Online Assistant via email to all personnel:
 - IVAOs: Send to all installation personnel
 - UVAOs: Send to all members of your unit
 - Link to the Online Assistant: <u>https://www.fvap.gov/r3/fpca/jurisdiction</u>
 - Reminder: You must complete in-hand delivery of the FPCA to all members of your unit/installation by July 15
- Offer assistance in completing the form.
- Conduct nonpartisan voting workshops and registration drives. Invite election officials from your area to assist.

- Hang voting banners near installation entrances or display a voting slogan on installation marquees.
- Run voting Public Service Announcements (PSAs) at the installation theater.
- Put up motivational posters with voter registration information in popular areas such as installation housing, gyms, commissaries and exchanges. Be sure to include your contact information.
- Use media outlets to encourage voter registration. Advertise events on Facebook and in installation newspapers.
- Plan your events around Independence Day.

- Ensure 100% contact of all members either in-person, via email, or by social media
- Collaborate on a voting drive with your nearest U.S. Embassy or Consulate
- Use FVAP videos on social media or at the movie theater
- Display voting banners at the main gates
- Hold adult and youth voting poster contests
- Booth/Table at local 4th of July events
- Use tablet to display the functionality of FVAP.gov and online assistants at Commissary/Exchange

- Partner with the Installation Post Office (particularly overseas) to share voting information
- Create "Send Your Vote Home t-shirts
- Commanders "Send Your Vote Home" dunk booth
- Loud speaker announcements
- Share information via installation television and radio
