### **OBJECTIVES**

- -Enhance the operational readiness of the various components and promote interoperability in terms of tactics, technics and procedures;
- -Plan and conduct combined air and maritime air missions as well as maritime interdiction operations;
- -Reinforce the manoeuvrability of the forces to operate in an austere environment with real fire execution in tactical environment;
- -Organize joint training in the fight against violent extremist organizations;
- -Conduct joint civil-military actions and exchange of expertise in the field of medical support in operations.





#### JOINT OBJECTIVES



- Strengthen the skills of FAR officers in mastering the operational planning process;


