

J6 Senior Communications Symposium 2021 VTC

1. PURPOSE & BACKGROUND

Purpose: The United States Africa Command (USAFRICOM) J6 will conduct a Military-to-Military (M2M) virtual engagement with African Partner Nation Senior Communicators from 4-6 May. The J6 will host the teleconference via Microsoft Teams from the USAFRICOM Headquarters. The teleconference will be comprised of a systems check on 4 May and two half-day afternoon sessions on both 5-6 May. The purpose of this engagement is to support the AFRICOM Campaign Plan (ACP) to Strengthen Partner Relationships through Enhancing Partner Capabilities. This event elevates the growing relationship with countries in USAFRICOM's Area of Responsibility (AOR) and institutionalizes standard communication practices in our partners' militaries.

Background: The theme for this year's conference is "Enhancing Partnerships through Secure Cyberspace." The symposium will focus on vital cybersecurity and Interoperability, Continuity of Operations (COOP), with an emphasis on cyber crisis response issues facing our partner nations during this global pandemic, and strengthening our partners' cyber and interoperability capabilities. This event will include several presentations from U.S. government personnel and an extended opportunity for the participants to share perspectives and lessons from their respective national cybersecurity strategies and pandemic response issues in the cyber domain. The participants should have some familiarity with the United States communications capabilities through the Africa Endeavor communications interoperability symposium and other engagements such as Operation Enduring Freedom-Trans Sahara. We are seeking to elevate enduring relationships and institutionalize standard communications practices by inviting key signal/communications personnel to participate in this Senior Leader Seminar. We anticipate approximately 12-14 African Partner Military Officers to participate.

Goals (in priority order):

- 1. Connect with partners and reinforce USAFRICOM's commitment to these partnerships, despite COVID-related limitations.
- 2. Inform partners about topics applicable to enabling their military missions through C4.
- 3. Evaluate utility of virtual engagements and develop lessons learned.
