WHAT TO EXPECT:

- Incumbent responsibilities may include scraping and pre-rinsing dishes, glasses, and flatware for washing.
- Maintain concept environment, equipment, utensils, and surfaces in a sanitary clean and neat condition.
- Set up glasses, silverware, butter, condiments, salads, desserts, bread, and cold beverages on serving counter as instructed.
- Serves food cafeteria style to diners.
- Performs tasks with several steps or sequence of tasks such as: sets up food service counters, steam tables, dining room tables, hot and cold food service stands.
- Prepares fruits and vegetables for cooking and serving by washing, peeling, scraping, and dicing.
- Cleans equipment in kitchen and dining area.
- Clears and cleans dining tables, sweeps, mops, and waxes floors.
- Moves heavy garbage cans and assists in unloading supply trucks and storing heavy supplies.
- Performs other duties as assigned.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:

- Must be able to multi-task and use good judgment.
- Must have the ability to concentrate on uniform individual portions and to take multiple orders upon customer's requests.
- Knowledge of sanitation standards in handling and serving food.
- Knowledge of basic arithmetic may be necessary.
- Must have the ability to work safely by moving carts without running into things, stacking dishes without mishaps, and wiping up spilled foods and liquids to prevent falls.
- Must understand personal hygiene standards such as wearing a hairnet and washing hands before touching food and not touching rims of cups/glasses.
- Ability to read and understand written instructions and material such as schedules, menus, and recipes.
- Ability to follow oral directions and routine manual tasks involving a few steps.



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CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT:

- Successful completion of National Agency Check (NACI) background check with written inquiries.
- Must be able to obtain a Food Handler's Certificate.
- Must be able to use simple kitchen equipment and use common utensils.
- Must be able to operate a cash register.
- Must be able to follow food recipes and combine ingredients for pizza, salads, and other menu items.
- Work involves light to moderate physical effort such as frequently lifting or moving objects weighing up to 30 pounds, constantly standing and walking, and occasionally lifting up to 45 pounds.

OTHER INFORMATION:

- Participation in the Direct Deposit/Electronic Fund Transfer within 30 days of employment is required.
- This position has a schedule that may involve weekends, and holidays, as well as rotating shifts, often consisting of other than normal duty hours.
