1. The Squadron Leadership Course (SLC) will be held at the Parr Club, JBSA-Randolph. The purpose of the course is to provide inbound squadron commanders, senior enlisted leaders, and spouses across AETC to connect in-person and to receive guidance and leadership perspective from the AETC/CC for success as a Command Team. The 2023 SLCs are schedule for 23-27 January (23A), 27-31 March (23B), 8-12 May (23C), and 26-30 June (23D).
2. The spouse agenda includes in-person briefings with the AETC/CC, the AETC/CCC, the AETC/CC's spouse, Mrs. Robinson, and the AETC/CCC's spouse, Mrs. Thompson.
