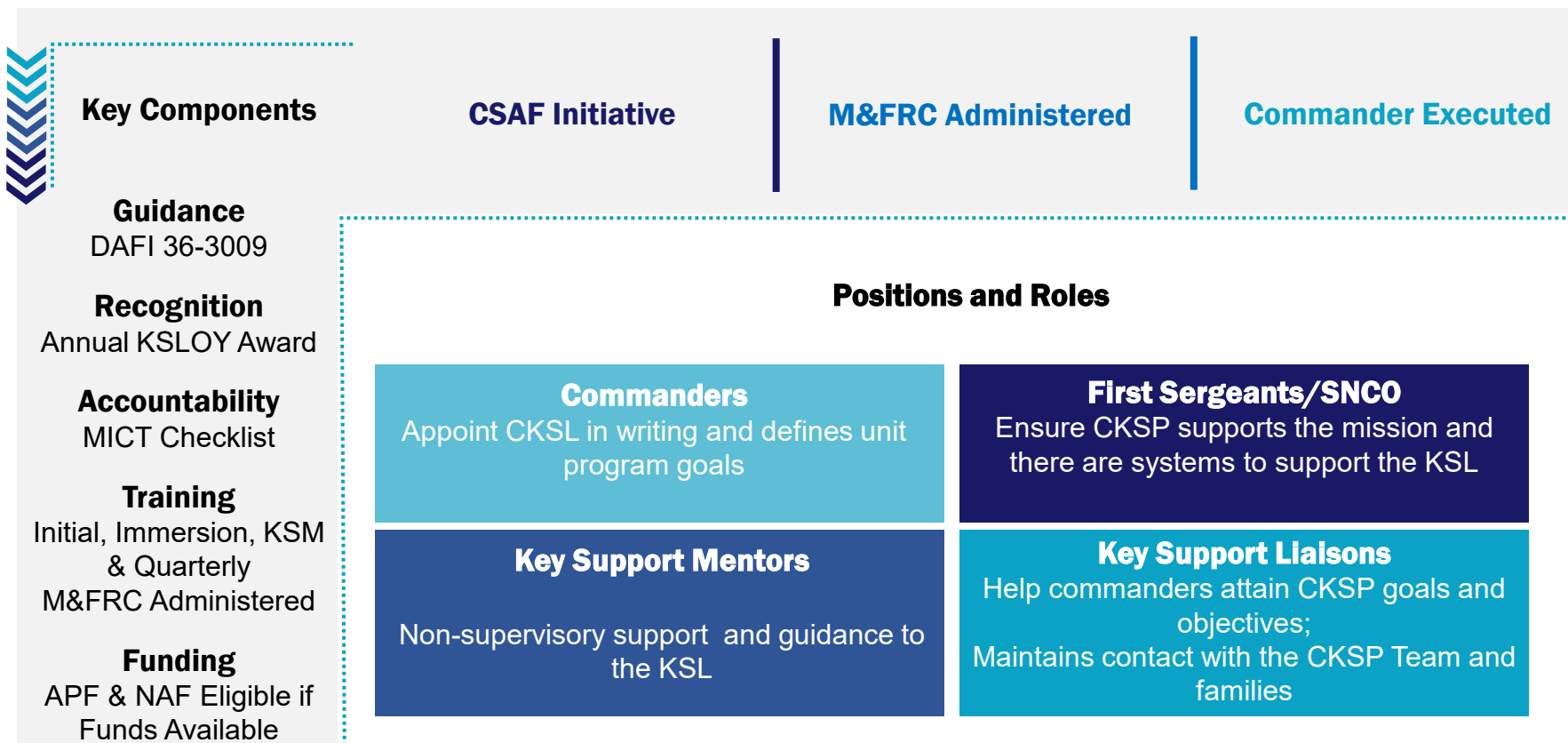

Scenario

An F3 tornado has caused significant damage to your unit's hometown and the surrounding community. The tornado touched down at 3:38 am on August 12, 2026, causing damage to buildings used for child and youth care, housing, and the commissary/shopping areas on base and off base. The tornado also caused widespread power outages affecting 40,000 customers and resulted in 11 deaths in the county.
