Summary

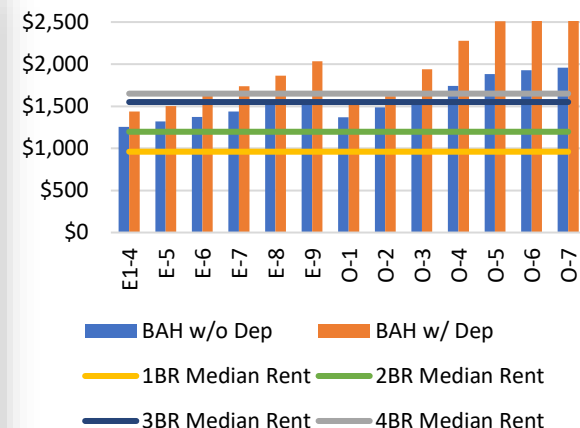

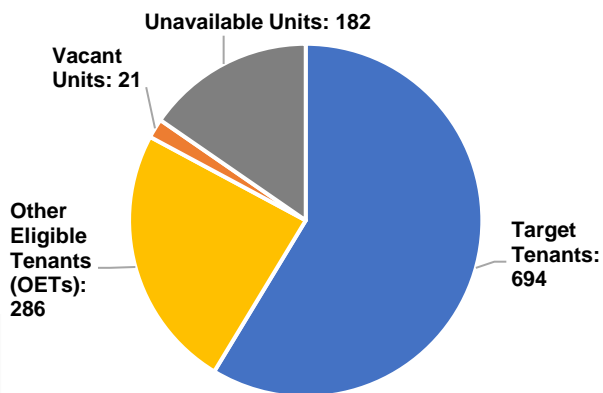
BAH⁶ & Median Rents⁷

Privatized Housing^{3&5}

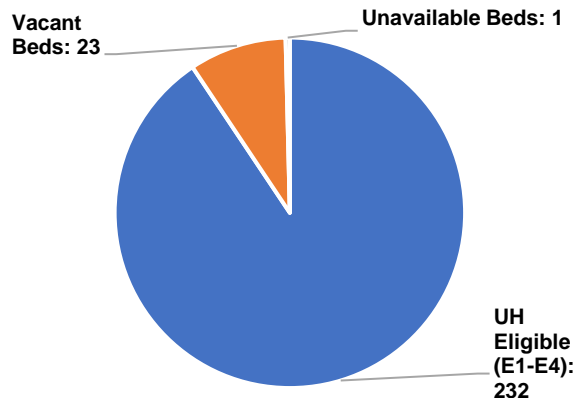

Unaccompanied Housing (UH)⁵

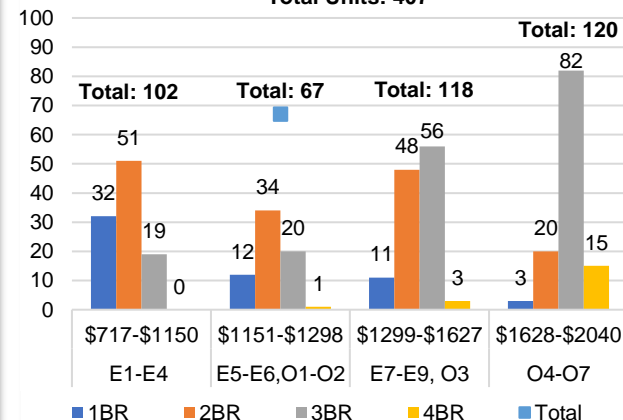
