Summary


The purpose of this Housing at a Glance report is to present information about the housing within the Little Rock Air Force Base (AFB) on- and off-base communities. Based on AFCEC/CIM's analysis, Service members and their families arriving at Little Rock AFB will find housing available both on- and off-base but face a limited supply of 4-bedroom units in the community.


BAH⁶ & Median Rents⁷

Privatized Housing^{3&5}



Unaccompanied Housing (UH)⁵


Total Beds: 602

24/7 gateway to trusted information, resources, and confidential help for military members and their families.




Toll-free number available 24/7 for Residents to communicate any housing concerns.
