



DURIP is an Office of the Under Secretary of Defense, Research and Engineering (OUSDRE) sponsored tri-service program designed to improve the basic research capabilities of accredited United States (US) institutions of higher education to conduct research and to educate scientists and engineers in areas important to national defense by providing funds for the acquisition of research equipment or instrumentation.

Program Attributes

- 12-month awards for acquisition of basic research equipment/instrumentation
- Capacity building in areas of vital importance to DoD – research and human capital
- Long-term investment via short grant
- No past, current, or future DoD funding required and no citizenship requirements
- DURIP is not a research award
