The Air Force Office of Scientific Research is hosting the 4th semi-annual MISTEC workshop this June in Arlington, VA. The MISTEC initiative seeks to facilitate increased collaborative activity and awareness among federal agencies that have international missions related to basic science and/or global S&T awareness.

The two objectives of this workshop are:

1. Provide a description of each agency's international S&T current activities and future plans with an emphasis on progress since the Nov 2016 MISTEC meeting.
2. Build relationships.

Agency representatives will be giving presentations that provide an update on their international S&T current activities and future plans. The tentative agenda includes presentations by the State Department/STAS, State Department/OES, National Science Foundation, Defense Technical Information Center, Army Research Office, Office of Net Technical Intelligence, Homeland Security Advanced Research Projects Agency, Office of the Secretary of Defense, Intelligence Advanced Research Projects Activity, and the Air Force Office of Scientific Research. People from a number of other federal agencies will be in attendance. Some time is set aside at the end of the workshop for discussion on ways ahead.
