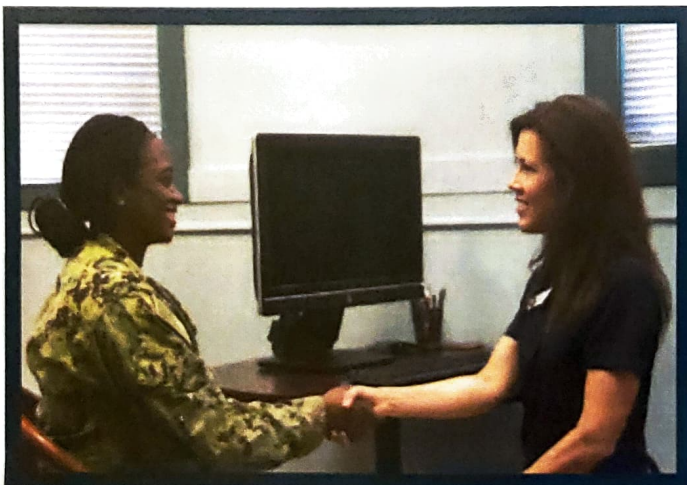

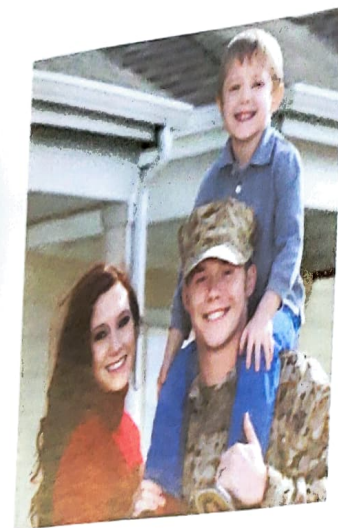

- Interest-free loans and grants for emergency and unexpected financial needs
- Budget and financial education to help you create and manage a monthly budget and save for future expenses
- Free in-home visits by a registered nurse to provide health education, baby wellness check-ups and address other health issues*
- Financial assistance for family members seeking post-secondary education
- Budget for Baby® workshops to help expectant parents prepare for the arrival of a new family member. Attendees receive a free Junior Sea Bag with a hand-made blanket
- Thrift Shops offering gently-used uniform items, clothing and household items at very low prices*
- No-Interest Quick Assist Loan® (up to \$500 and 5 times in career) available to active duty Sailors and Marines to meet urgent financial needs
- Financial assistance for food, shelter and transportation to aid evacuation or recovery from a natural disaster



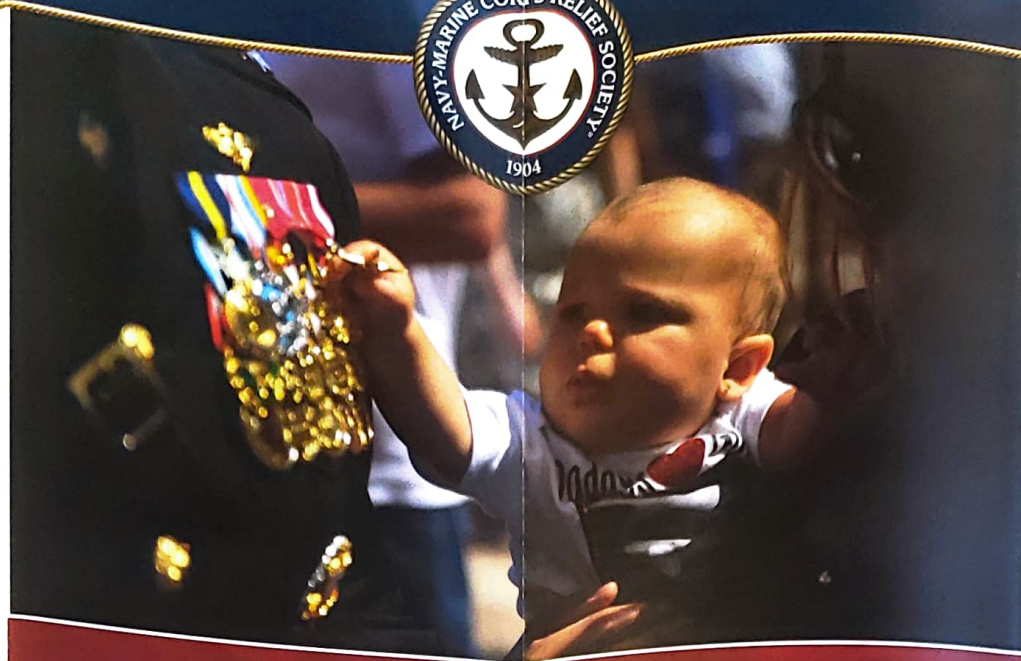

WHO WE SERVE

- Active duty and retired Navy and Marine Corps personnel and their eligible family members
- Eligible family members of Navy and Marine Corps personnel who died on active duty or in a retired status
- Reservists on extended active duty for 30 days or more
- Indigent widows and dependent parents (65 years or older) of deceased service members who have limited resources and no family to provide for their welfare
- Ex-spouses who have not remarried and whose marriage to a service member lasted for at least 20 years while the service member was on active duty

In an emergency, the Society can provide assistance for:

- Food, rent and utilities
- Transportation expenses
- Essential vehicle repairs
- Medical and dental co-pays
- Disaster relief assistance
- Funeral expenses

The Society offers free, in-home visits by Registered Nurses to active duty and retired Sea Service members and their families, widows and widowers. Our visiting nurses provide health education, resource referral and support for:

- Prenatal and postpartum concerns
- Newborn care and breastfeeding concerns
- Pediatric, adult, and geriatric health concerns

Society visiting nurses travel within a 50-mile radius of the local NMCRS office to visit clients in their homes.
