ATP 7-100.3, Chinese Tactics supports the DoD-wide shift to China and the Pacific, and is its first comprehensive open-source publication on PLA tactics since the *Handbook on the Chinese People's Liberation Army* was published by DIA in 1984. It is written based directly on PLA sources.
